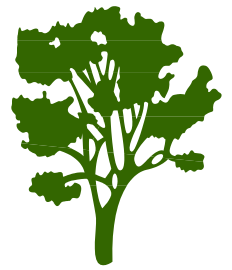

A New Community Garden and Food Growing Space in the Heart of Whitstable

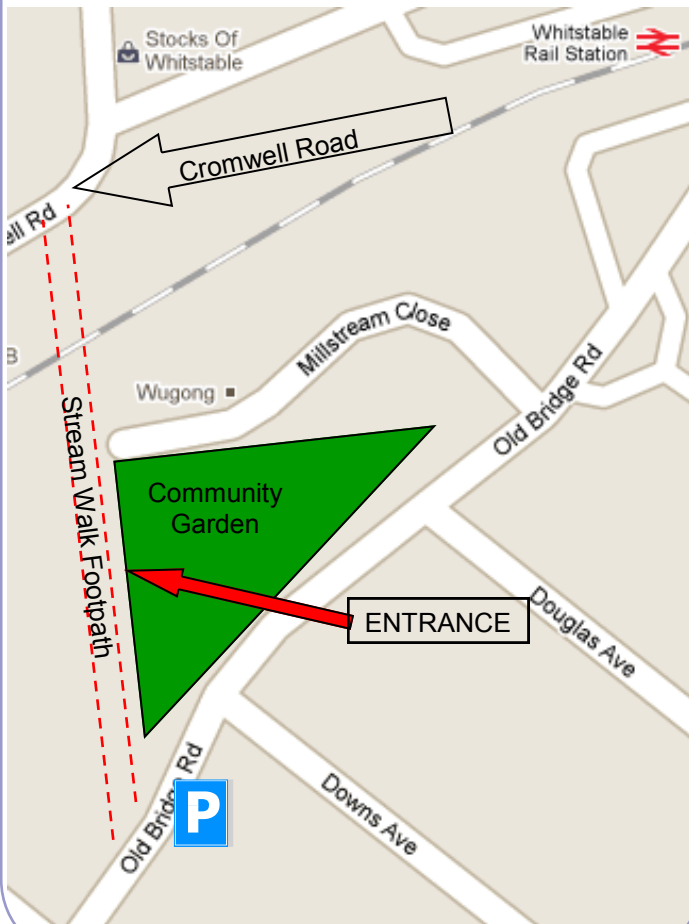


STREAM WALK IS.....
